The Luverne Alumni Hall of Fame accepts nominations from the public based on the following criteria:

- 1. The nominee may be living or deceased.
- 2. The nominee must be someone who attended Luverne Public Schools for a minimum of 8 (eight) years or who has graduated from Luverne High School.
- 3. The nominee must have led an exemplary life of good character following graduation.

SELECTION

Luverne Alumni Hall of Fame inductees will be selected based on the following criteria:

- 1. Excellence in their profession.
- 2. Exceptional service, volunteerism or contributions to community on a local, regional, state, national or international level.
- 3. Excellence in personal endeavors that are recognized on a local, regional, state, national or international level.
- 4. Exceptional contributions to education at a local, regional, state, national or international level.

NOMINATION AND INDUCTION PROCEDURES

Nominations are accepted annually with the opening date of March 1st and closing date of February 28th the following year.

Nominations may be made by alumni, current or former faculty and staff, administrators and community members of Luverne Public Schools.

Nominations will be kept on file and reconsidered for the next five years following submission. Candidates may be re-nominated if not selected.

An annual induction ceremony is planned for the fall of each year during the weekend of the Luverne High School Homecoming Football Game.
