MINUTES OF THE SCHOOL BOARD MEETING OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2184, ROCK COUNTY, LUVERNE, MINNESOTA. A special meeting of the Board of Education, ISD #2184, was held online via Zoom from the District Office on March 19, 2020, at 7:00 p.m.

Chairperson Bosch called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Technology Coordinator Wade Hiller reviewed some of the guidelines and operations of the Zoom system. Jodi Bosch informed the School Board that all motions would be acted on via a roll call vote.

Motion made by Baustian, second by Deutsch, to approve the agenda as presented. Those who voted in favor: Jarchow, Baustian, Sehr, Deutsch, Hartman, Sandbulte and Bosch. Those who voted against: none. Motion unanimously carried.

Superintendent Oftedahl gave an update on school related COVID-19 issues.

Motion made by Sehr, second by Jarchow, to ratify the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 Master Agreement with the Luverne Education Association. Those who voted in favor: Jarchow, Baustian, Sehr, Deutsch, Hartman, Sandbulte and Bosch. Those who voted against: none. Motion unanimously carried.

The upcoming meeting dates were reviewed. It was noted that these meetings may need to be via technology.
