## WEATHER RELATED ANNOUNCEMENTS

### **Notification:**

Weather related announcements will be announced through:

- Radio Station: KQAD, Luverne AM 800, FM 101.1
- TV Stations: KELO, KDLT, KSFY

The Luverne School District also utilizes our School Messenger System to notify parents of any changes in our school day. Parents will receive an automated phone message as well as a text message to cell phones.

## Parents are encouraged to inform the school of their most current contact information to ensure proper notification.

#### No School:

In the event that schools are closed for the day, Luverne Public Schools will implement an E-Learning Day. In the Elementary School:

- Teachers will send an attendance prompt through Google Classroom or SeeSaw. Students need to respond to this prompt to be counted present for the day.
- E-Learning Plans for the elementary school take the form of a Bingo card. Students should complete one assignment in each column. Parents are to verify the assignments their student completes and this information should come back to school the next day.
- E-Learning plans for each grade can be found on our elementary school webpage under "Shortcuts".
- Teachers will be available via email on E-Learning days from 10:00am to 3:00pm.

#### 2-Hour Late Start:

There may be instances when it will be necessary for school to start late. In those situations, a message will go out via our School Messenger System. In most cases of a late start, school will generally start 2 hours late.

- When school starts 2 hours late, the class day will begin at 10:00am. Starting 2 hours late will mean that morning pick-up or drop-off will be pushed back two hours. For example, if your child gets picked up by the bus at 7:30am, they will then be picked up around 9:30am.
- Breakfast will **NOT** be served at school on late start days, please plan accordingly.

## **Early Dismissal:**

The district may implement an early dismissal for a few specific reasons, the most common reason is due to inclement weather.

- When early dismissal is required, parents will be notified of an early dismissal via our School Messenger System.
- The district typically gives parents an hour and a half notice of an early dismissal.
- The **BEST** way to get a message to your child is to <u>call the office</u>. Teachers may not have time to check their emails or there may be a substitute teacher who does not have access to the teacher's email.
- There will be **NO** Family U when we have an early dismissal.
- In the case of an early dismissal due to weather, all school related practices and activities scheduled for the evening will be postponed or canceled.

Families should discuss backup plans for inclement weather.
